## The Search for Financial Assistance

As an international student interested in attending the Georgetown University Law Center, you should be aware that you are expected to have sufficient funding to finance your entire course of study. The Law Center does not offer grants or scholarships to international students. Therefore, international students will need to obtain funding through personal resources, government or private funding.

Also, contact local organizations for possible scholarships (i.e. Chambers of Commerce in your home country), particularly if these organizations reflect your own educational, religious, ethnic, or geographic background.
