**ZIP CAR INFORMATION 2007**

Dear Foundations students:

Georgetown Law Center is one of the "Zipcar" sites in Washington, D.C. Zipcar is a service that allows you to rent a car for a temporary amount of time to run errands without the hassle of public transportation and commuting. Zipcar spots are located close to many Metro stations, including Union Station, and there are two cars at the Law Center. You must join in advance to reserve cars; you can join by going to <[www.zipcar.com/georgetown](http://www.zipcar.com/georgetown)>. Prices are around \$7.65 per hour or \$65.00 a day. This includes Insurance, parking, gas, mileage (under 125 miles), and maintenance.

There are some special requirements for international drivers which you should review prior to departing for the U.S. It may be easier to bring this information with you rather than try to get it from home after you arrive.

You must:

- Have a valid driver's license from the U.S. or another country
- Be 21+ (no extra fees for drivers under 25)
- Have had no more than two "incidents" (moving violations plus accidents) in the past three years and no more than one incident in the past 18 months
- Have had no major violations in the past three years
- Have had no alcohol violations in the past seven years

International applicants must provide a driving record from their country's motor vehicle records department. When you have your record, fax it to Zipcar's insurer Member Services at (617) 995-4300. Be sure to indicate Zipcar application on the fax. Students may also want to bring along a copy of their driver's license.
