Upon request, Georgetown Law will seek Continuing Legal Education (CLE) accreditation for the 2007 Academy of WTO Law & Policy from states with mandatory CLE requirements. Georgetown Law is an accredited CLE provider in most MCLE states. Georgetown CLE is a State Bar of California approved MCLE provider.
