Jonathan Liberman is Senior Legal Policy Adviser for the International Union Against Cancer (UICC), and Senior Adviser, International Legal Policy at the Cancer Council Victoria in Melbourne, Australia. Jonathan has been working on legal and policy issues relating to cancer prevention and treatment at the state, national and international levels for over 10 years. From March 2006 to March 2009, Jonathan was Policy Director of the Framework Convention Alliance, the main international NGO working on the development and implementation of the WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control. In his current role, Jonathan works across a range of international legal and policy issues, including international approaches to prevent cancers caused by tobacco, alcohol and unhealthy diet, and the treatment of cancer patients, particularly with respect to access to pain relief medication.
