GLOBAL HEALTH LAW AND GOVERNANCE SUMMER PROGRAM

Over a five-day period, the Summer Program will bring together practitioners, policymakers, advocates and leading academics in global health to learn the foundations of global health law and governance.

The Summer Program will explore why global health and global health law are emerging as central issues of multilateral concern; why existing global governance systems are frequently ineffective; and the strengths and limitations of international law as a tool for improving the health of the world's population, especially the poorest and most vulnerable.

The Summer Program will provide an excellent opportunity for professional development and networking in an interdisciplinary setting.

THE O'NEILL INSTITUTE FOR NATIONAL AND GLOBAL HEALTH LAW

The O'Neill Institute at Georgetown University was established in 2007 through the generous philanthropy of Linda and Timothy O'Neill to respond to the need for innovative solutions to the most pressing national and international health concerns. Housed at Georgetown Law in Washington, DC, the O'Neill Institute reflects the importance of public and private law in health policy analysis. The O'Neill Institute draws upon the University's considerable intellectual resources, including the School of Medicine, School of Nursing & Health Studies, the Public Policy Institute, and the Kennedy Institute of Ethics.

Courses

During the five-day Summer Program, the following topics will be covered:

- Introduction to Global Health Law and Governance
- Health and Security
- International Trade and Health
- The Significance of Human Rights in Global Health Governance
- The International Health Regulations
- Framework Convention on Tobacco Control
- WHO Code of Practice on the International Recruitment of Health Personnel
- The Global Challenge of Non-communicable Diseases

Courses will be taught by leading global health law and governance experts from the O'Neill Institute, international institutions, such as the World Health Organization, World Trade Organization, academia, and legal practice.

LAWRENCE O. GOSTIN, an internationally acclaimed scholar, is University Professor, Georgetown University's highest academic rank conferred by the University President. Professor Gostin directs the O'Neill Institute for National and Global Health Law and was the Founding O'Neill Chair in Global Health Law. He served as Associate Dean for Research at Georgetown Law from 2004 to 2008. He is Professor of Medicine at

Georgetown University, Professor of Public Health at the Johns Hopkins University, and Director of the Center for Law & the Public's Health at Johns Hopkins and Georgetown universities.



ALLYN TAYLOR, J.D., LL.M., J.S.D., joined Georgetown Law as a Visiting Professor of Law in 2007. She is also an adjunct professor of international relations at the Johns Hopkins University Paul H. Nitze School of Advanced International Studies. With almost twenty years of experience as a scholar and practitioner in the field, Dr. Taylor is recognized as a leading authority in global health law.
