Earn \$5000 this summer interning at the Archdiocesan Legal Network
& the DC Office of Foley & Lardner

Foley & Lardner will award a \$5000 stipend to one first year Georgetown law student to spend 6-7 weeks at the Archdiocesan Legal Network (ALN) and 3-4 weeks at Foley & Lardner in DC.

The Pro Bono Internship is designed to encourage law students to incorporate pro bono and public interest work into their legal careers and to offer students an opportunity to provide legal services to low income clients in the District of Columbia.

While at ALN, the *Pro Bono* Intern will: develop, promote, and facilitate community legal education seminars that are open to members of the DC legal and social work communities, as well as members of the public; coordinate and conduct client intake; manage cases of clients seeking *pro bono* legal services; recruit volunteer attorneys for clients with a variety of civil law matters; train and coordinate ALN volunteers; build coalitions with other non-profit agencies serving low-income residents of DC and Maryland; and help develop with ALN newsletters and other public relations materials.

While at Foley & Lardner, the *Pro Bono* Intern will work exclusively on pro bono matters, including any cases brought over from ALN.
