

## HOWREY/GEORGETOWN TWO-YEAR *PRO BONO* FELLOWSHIP

Howrey LLP and Georgetown University Law Center are pleased to announce the 2008-2010 Howrey/Georgetown *Pro Bono* Fellowship. The two-year fellowship will be awarded to a graduating Georgetown J.D. law student who has a strong commitment to public interest law. The *Pro Bono* Fellow will work in Howrey's DC office for two years exclusively on pro bono matters under the direction and supervision of Howrey's Pro Bono Partner. The Fellowship is intended to prepare a graduating law student for a career in public interest at a nonprofit legal service provider or at another firm coordinating *pro bono* matters.

The *Pro Bono* Fellow will work on cases and assist in the administration of Howrey's extensive *Pro Bono* program. The Fellow's responsibilities will include:

- Working on *pro bono* cases in various areas including, for example, adoption, asylum, social security, discrimination, custody, domestic violence, and police misconduct
- Organizing and participating in training sessions in different areas of public interest law
- Helping publish the firm's annual *pro bono* report and periodic *pro bono* updates
- Participating and assisting in the management of Howrey's "Partnership In Education" program, through which Howrey provides tutoring, fundraising, and other activities for an elementary school in D.C.
- Staffing clinics at the Archdiocesan Legal Network and the D.C. Bar

There is no billable hour requirement; the *Pro Bono* Fellow will work full time on *pro bono* matters, which will be at least 40 hours a week, but could be more depending on the demands of the caseload and courts.

Candidates should possess a demonstrated commitment to public interest law and a strong academic record.
