

Off-Campus Living

Checklist for International Students

Before you begin your journey in search of off-campus housing, the following documentation and/or items may be required before signing your lease.

- ◆ **Guarantor**—One who resides in the United States and undertakes collaterally to assure satisfaction of the debt of another or perform the obligation of another if and when the debtor fails to do so.
- ◆ **Completed Application and Application Fee**
- ◆ **Copy of Passport**
- ◆ **Copy of I-20/IAP-66 or Student Visa**
- ◆ **Acceptance Letter from GULC**
- ◆ **Letter from GULC Student Accounts or Financial Aid Office with account status**
- ◆ **Payment in full for the term of lease (Many management companies will accept the full payment for the term of your lease in lieu of a guarantor. However, this method of obtaining a lease may not be accepted by all management companies.)**
