**Resolution #0820: Financial Aid Office Resolution**

WHEREAS there are student concerns regarding the efficiency and procedures of the Financial Aid office

WHEREAS for the second consecutive semester, the Financial Aid office has delayed sending students time sensitive, legally required notices informing them of their right to return loan funds by a month which forfeits their ability to return the money

WHEREAS the Financial Aid office may materially benefit from this procedure

WHEREAS a more efficient procedure would be advantageous to students

Be it hereby resolved that:

1. The SBA President will appoint two members to meet with the Financial Aid office by March 10<sup>th</sup> and report back to SBA with the findings.
2. The SBA will ask the Financial Aid office to provide more transparency in its overall operations and ask it to provide time sensitive materials to students in a timelier manner.
3. The SBA will inform the student body of any facts of the situation which would affect the Financial Aid mailing procedures in the future.
