Resolution #0815: J. Reuben Clark funding

WHEREAS J. Reuben Clark Society, Catholic Law Forum, Christian Legal Society, and Jewish Law Students' Association are officially recognized and Association-funded student groups at Georgetown Law in good standing with the Georgetown Law administration and the Association;

WHEREAS an event co-sponsored by these groups and potentially the Muslim Law Students' Association bringing the Chaplains of the United States Senate and House of Representatives to Georgetown Law on February 24, 2009 to speak and interact with students as part of Culture Fusion Week is a valuable opportunity for students and the Georgetown Law community;

WHEREAS the Treasurer and SBA Appropriations Committee have approved a supplemental funding request for \$631.00 to pay for a reception following the Chaplains' appearance;

And

WHEREAS the Treasurer and the SBA Appropriations Committee are required to seek approval from the SBA House of Delegates for any expenditure of Association funds over the amount of \$500;

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the SBA House of Delegates approve the expenditure of \$631.00 of Association funds to be deposited into the account of the student group J. Reuben Clark Society, for the purpose of paying for a co-sponsored reception following the Congressional Chaplains' appearance at Georgetown Law on February 24, 2009.
