Resolutions

- SBA Constitutional Amendment 08-01
 - Add a Joint degree representative to SBA.
 - Can joint degrees vote for more than one person—i.e. joint degree representative plus other representatives.
 - Move to amend: Add point number:
 - Once a student is classified as a joint degree student, that student shall only vote for a Joint Degree representative.
 - Motion to table.

- Resolution 08-10—Exam printing. Katherine Hayes
 - Hand students a CD—can do exams for less than 24 hours.
 - The only reason for the policy is that it is their policy.
 - Phrasing is less than 24 hours.
 - Professors get exams in paper anyway.
 - This is only for a small group.
 - Unanimous vote—28 votes FOR- 0 AGAINST

- Resolution 08-11—Informed about exam procedure.
 - Notifying students about the room they're in—after contracts mid-term and LRW finals where they were not informed about the rooms or procedures.
