Resolution 3: Appointments for the 2008-2009 Term

WHEREAS Article IV, Section 2(a) requires the Student Bar Association President to “make such appointments and delegations not envisioned by this Constitution as are necessary to perform the duties of President and the continuing operations of the Association”;

WHEREAS Article VI, Section 1(c) states that “all Chairpersons of Standing Committees shall be nominated by the Executive Board and confirmed by the House of Delegates”;

WHEREAS Article VI, Section 2(c), states that “[t]he Chair(s) of an Ad Hoc Committee must be a Delegate and shall be approved as Chair(s) by the House of Delegates”;

WHEREAS Article IV, Section 2(f), in relevant parts, states that the Attorney General shall “be appointed subject to the approval of the full House of Delegates by a two thirds majority” and “chair the Judiciary Committee”;

WHEREAS, the Appointments Committee has solicited and received recommendations on the structure and composition of Student Bar Association committees for the 2008-2009 term; made available draft versions for comment on April 8 and 14; and incorporated revisions to the best of its ability.

Be it hereby resolved that:

1. The Law Center Affairs Committee shall be chaired by Skornicki, in his capacity as President, and include all chairs, co-chairs, and members of the following four subcommittees:
 - the Food and Fitness subcommittee shall be chaired by Olowski and include Arora, Chanoine, Drake, Henderson, Nelson and Price;
 - the Facilities and Sustainability subcommittee shall be chaired by Rivon and include Durkin, Griffith, Hughes, McCauley, Sacks, and Streja;
 - the Technology subcommittee shall be co-chaired by Chanoine and Brown and include Drake, Durkin, and Hughes; and
 - the Mental Health subcommittee shall be chaired by Sacks and include Griffith, Mohammad, and White.
2. The standing Appropriations Committee shall be chaired by Harvey, in his capacity as Treasurer, and include Brown, Griffin, Griffith, Igbokwe, James, McCauley, Nelson, Olowski, Pittman, and Prince.

3. The standing Elections Committee shall be co-chaired by McCauley and Griffin and include Durkin, White, and Williams.
4. The standing Evening Students Affairs Committee shall be chaired by Colquitt, in his capacity as Evening Vice President, and include Hedger and Tetelman.
5. The standing Judiciary Committee shall be chaired by Pittman, who shall be Attorney General, and include Brown, Durkin, Drake, Nelson and Price.
6. The standing Social Committee shall be co-chaired by Arora and Williams and include Chanoine, Griffith, James, Olowski, Price, Rivon, Romerdahl, and Sorensen.
7. The standing LLM Committee shall include Griffith and McCauley, and the Appointments Committee shall nominate a chair during the 2008-2009 academic year.
