Resolution 4: Sentiment of SBA on the Release of WriteOn Results

WHEREAS each year many 1L students participate in both the WriteOn journal competition and Early Interview Week;

WHEREAS many employers at EIW value journal membership and look for it in candidates for employment;

WHEREAS it is in the best interest of each law student to create an EIW bid list that most accurately reflects his or her qualifications and resume;

WHEREAS in years past WriteOn results have been released after bid lists and resumes of EIW participants are required to be submitted; and,

WHEREAS it would be in the best interests of all students who participate in these two programs to have WriteOn results prior to the deadline for bid list and resume submission;

Be it hereby resolved that:

It is the sentiment of the Georgetown University Law Center Student Bar Association that WriteOn results should be released to students prior to the deadline for submission of resumes and bid lists for Early Interview Week and that a copy of this resolution be forwarded by the Secretary of SBA to the directors of the Journal Office, the Office of Career Services, the Dean of Students and the Registrar. And that in discussion with the administration regarding this topic, that concerns of transfer students be taken into consideration with regard to the timing of EIW and the equality with the student body as a whole.
