Resolution 0809: Saving Energy through Improved Fitness Center Technology

WHEREAS electricity is wasted when the personal television terminals on Sport and Fitness Center machinery remains on while the equipment is unused;

WHEREAS the Student Bar Association recognizes there is environmental and economic value in reducing the amount of electricity wasted by said personal television terminals;

WHEREAS many area gyms, including those operated by Town Sports International, employ personal television terminals that function only when users insert headphones into the terminal jack, enabling the conservation of energy when terminals are not in use.

Be it hereby resolved that it is the sense of the Student Bar Association that:

1. The Georgetown University Law Center Sport and Fitness Center should evaluate the costs and benefits of upgrading its current personal television terminals to employ technology that would enable the Law Center to conserve energy.
2. The Food and Fitness subcommittee of the Law Center Affairs Committee shall make the sense of the Association known to the appropriate persons at the Law Center and Sport and Fitness Center within one week and make reports to the Association via memorandum as to the progress of the Sports and Fitness Center's evaluation.
