Resolution #: Take Home Exam Printing Requirement

WHEREAS, the Office of the Registrar at Georgetown University Law Center requires that students turn in printed copies of all take home examinations regardless of the length of time given for the examination.

WHEREAS, most Georgetown University Law Center students live off-campus and stay on campus to complete take home exams of less than twenty four hours.

WHEREAS, students have access to a limited number of printers through the E.B. Williams and John Wolff Libraries.

WHEREAS, a printing requirement gives students less time to complete the exam than the professor intended.

WHEREAS, it should be a priority not to unnecessarily exacerbate exam-related anxiety

WHEREAS, the Office of the Registrar at Georgetown University Law Center requires student laptop users save work product to CDs for all in-class examinations.

Be it hereby resolved that:

1. It is the sense of the Student Bar Association that students should have the option of saving take home exams of less than twenty four hours to a CD.
2. A delegate to be designated by the Student Bar Association shall request this policy change from the Office of the Registrar at Georgetown University Law Center.
