Resolution #0817: Creation of Marketplace

And

1. The SBA will take steps to achieve the creation of a more efficient Marketplace website which allows easy posting and finding.
2. The SBA will take steps to make the "textbooks" section of the Marketplace website allow students to search by book name, author, subject, or ISBN number.
3. The SBA will take steps to make the "textbooks" section of the Marketplace website display results in a user-friendly manner, displaying only the books searched for in order by price.
4. The SBA will launch and advertise for a user-friendly, efficient Marketplace website after its creation has been achieved.
