

Dear Colleagues

Barring unforeseen circumstances, the 2nd Street sidewalk along the west side of the Tower Green will be closed from Monday, March 27, until Wednesday, March 29. BBC needs to move the fence to the east side of the sidewalk in order to get crane access to the site.

Moving the fence will start at 7:00 a.m. The crane is scheduled to arrive at 10:00 a.m. All of our buildings will remain accessible via the U shaped sidewalk that links Gewirz to McDonough Hall. BBC will have a flagman stationed at 2nd and F Streets to ensure the safety of our students, faculty, and staff.

Please be careful as you make your way through the area and follow the directions of our Facilities and Security staff and the BBC staff.

And from the D.C. Department of Transportation;

This is an important message from the District of Columbia AlertDC system.

(Washington, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will reopen the second lane on the I-395 Third Street Tunnel 2nd Street off-ramp by Sunday, April 2. The 2nd Street off-ramp has been restricted to a single lane since May 2015.

Reopening the second lane is expected to help improve traffic flow for vehicles exiting the highway toward Massachusetts Avenue, NW. Motorists should note that single-lane closures are expected on a regular basis through 2018 as the above-ground construction of the Capitol Crossing project continues.

Motorists, pedestrians and cyclists are urged to stay alert and use caution when traveling through the work zone.

This notice continues an ongoing public outreach effort that began 2013 for the Capitol Crossing project.
