Training:	The Trenton Restorative Street Team (TRST) builds strategic relationships by practicing the 5 L's method (Listen, Learn, Lament, Love, Lead).
Calls responded to per month:	Around 900.
Dispatch Process:	The 911 Emergency Call Center will receive calls directed from 211 and 988, and PIC units will be dispatched accordingly depending on the level of risk associated with the incident, 24/7.
