Letter responding to City's July 3, 2024 letter

Dear Ms. Gornik:

This letter responds to the City of St. Louis's July 3, 2024, letter. Despite the Supreme Court's decision in *Muldrow*—which the City does not deny eliminates the sole basis for this Court's earlier ruling—that letter urges this Court to effectively reverse the district court's pre-*Muldrow* determination that there are disputes of material fact that preclude summary judgment on Naes's Title VII sex-discrimination claim. *See* Pet. for R'hrg En Banc 4 (July 28, 2023) (describing district-court summary-judgment ruling).

Our April 18, 2024 letter explains why it would be appropriate for this Court to remand to the district court for further proceedings. We add only that if not for the quirk of *Muldrow*'s interposition, this Court would have lacked appellate jurisdiction to review the district court's interlocutory denial of summary judgment, *see, e.g.*, *Folta v. Norfolk Brewing Co.*, 88 F.4th 1266, 1267 (8th Cir. 2023), underscoring the prudence of the course we suggest.
