

HJA 2022 Summer Law Clerk Posting

The Georgetown University Health Justice Alliance Law Clinic seeks a law clerk for Summer 2022. The clinic provides legal advocacy to low-income families in Washington, D.C. through a medical-legal partnership between Georgetown University's Law and Medical Centers. The law clinic integrates attorneys and law students into community-based Georgetown health clinics in Washington, D.C. to investigate and address patients' identified legal needs that impact health and well-being. Patients at our partner health clinics face complex civil legal needs, including those related to education equity and access, housing justice, economic and food justice, access to health care, and racial justice. By meeting patients' legal needs in places where they already have trusted relationships, the HJA Law Clinic offers a unique and especially effective method to reduce barriers to justice for those who urgently need legal advocacy in our community.

The summer law clerk will work closely with supervising attorneys to provide legal services to our client families in a variety of practice areas. Summer law clerks engage in a wide range of legal activities, including conducting legal intakes with potential clients; interviewing clients, witnesses, and other parties; conducting other forms of fact investigation; connecting clients to resources in the community; collaborating with healthcare and social work partners; and legal research and writing, including memos, complaints, motions, and other advocacy documents.

Please be mindful that:

- **Rising 2Ls and rising 3Ls** will be considered for the position.
- This position will be largely remote, with some opportunities for in-person activities throughout the summer.
- **Both part-time and full-time applicants will be considered.** If applying for a part-time position, please clarify in your cover letter how many hours per week you could dedicate to clinic work.
- This position is **unpaid**; however, we are happy to help our summer law clerks complete any documentation necessary to obtain public interest funding through their law schools or other sources.
