CAPACITY-BUILDING & COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

In Summer 2021, Cancer LAW attorneys:



Attended provider meetings to collaborate on addressing ongoing patient legal trends as COVID-protections and restrictions change



Established on-site office hours at MWCI, increasing capacity for face-to-face services



Launched a collaboration with Cancer Support Community, a national non-profit, to develop resources specific to DC-area cancer patients
