



Resolution 2018-2019-1: Attorney General Appointment

WHEREAS Article V, Section 2(f)(i) states that the Attorney General shall “be a member of the Association nominated by the Executive Board and confirmed by a two-thirds majority of the House of Delegates”;

WHEREAS Article V, Section 2(f)(ii) states that the Attorney General shall “be the arbiter and interpreter of this Constitution and the Judiciary Committee Bylaws”;

WHEREAS Article V, Section 2(f)(iii) states that the Attorney General shall “advise the President and House of Delegates as to the proper interpretation and application of the rules of procedure set out in this Constitution, the Association Bylaws, the Judiciary Committee Bylaws, or any other rules of order adopted by the House of Delegates”;

WHEREAS Article V, Section 2(f)(iv) states that the Attorney General shall “chair the Judiciary Committee”;

WHEREAS Article V, Section 2(f)(v) states that the Attorney General shall “preside over debate in the House of Delegates”;

WHEREAS Article V, Section 2(f)(vi) states that the Attorney General shall “perform such other duties as the President or the House of Delegates may direct”;

WHEREAS Tyrone Pinkins has previously served as a 1L Delegate, has been a member of the Appropriations and Diversity Committees, and has extensive knowledge of the SBA Constitution and Bylaws as well as parliamentary procedure; and

WHEREAS Tyrone Pinkins has previously served our country for twenty-one years as an army officer, has served as Communications Aide to the President of the United States, has founded the Pyramid Project, which is a non-profit youth organization devoted to mentoring youth from underserved communities; and

WHEREAS the Executive Board finds Tyrone Pinkins to be qualified and capable candidate for the position of Attorney General;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

Tyrone Pinkins is confirmed as the Attorney General for the 2018-2019 House of Delegates.
