**Resolution 2019-2020-4: Honoring the Life of Cedric Asiavugwa**

WHEREAS, on the morning of Sunday, March 10 Ethiopian Airlines Flight ET302 crashed outside of Addis Ababa, Ethiopia just moments after taking off; and

WHEREAS, all 157 passengers and crew, from 35 countries, were lost as a result of the crash; and

WHEREAS, one of those passengers lost was Cedric Asiavugwa, a 3L at Georgetown University Law Center; and

WHEREAS, Cedric was born and raised in Mombasa, Kenya and held a degree from the University of Zimbabwe; and

WHEREAS, his commitment to social justice would lead him to apply and attend the Georgetown University Law Center as a Global Law Scholar and Public Interest Law Scholar; and

WHEREAS, he nurtured his passion for public service by working at OPICS his 1L year and by participating in the Center for Applied Legal Studies clinic; and

WHEREAS, his participation in both on- and off-campus activities to mentor other students and two clinic programs for refugees and women's rights across borders showed his relentless dedication to making this world a better place; and

WHEREAS, Cedric could be found frequenting the Campus Ministry office where he was always available to offer words of wisdom and support to his friends and peers alike; and

THEREFORE, we ask all members of the Georgetown University community to remember Cedric Asiavugwa's zeal for life, the law, and social justice; and

FURTHERMORE, offer our deepest condolences to his family and all those who are struggling to cope with this tragic loss.
