# LL.M. SUMMER EXPERIENCE

**JULY 13 - AUGUST 21 2020**

Georgetown University Law Center offers its incoming one-year LL.M. students the option of taking courses in the summer before the LL.M. program begins.

## THE PROGRAM

### Session I: July 13-July 31

Foundations of American Law (2 credits) provides a gateway for internationally educated LL.M. students studying in the United States, introducing them to the basics of American law and to the special dynamics of the U.S. law school classroom before they begin a full schedule of classes in the fall semester. Students will learn about the U.S. legal system, common law reasoning, and contemporary legal issues in the United States. Students will earn 2 credits for this course, which they can apply toward their LL.M. degree. This course has also been approved by the New York Bar to satisfy its requirement for 2 credits in a course on American legal studies.\*

### Session II: August 3-21

**Choice A:** Professional Responsibility in the U.S. (2 credits) is open to all incoming internationally educated students, but may be especially appealing to those planning to sit for the New York Bar exam after graduation.\*

**Choice B:** U.S. Legal Research, Analysis and Writing (2 credits) introduces internationally educated LL.M. students to U.S. legal resources, research methods and analytical paradigms.\*

Enrollment in the Summer Experience is optional. It is open only to internationally educated students who confirm their intent to enroll for the Georgetown LL.M. in the 2020-21 academic year. Many students appreciate the early start provided by the Summer Experience, as they become familiar with the Law Center and Washington before the start of the fall semester. It can be especially helpful to those students planning to sit for the New York Bar exam after graduation, as it enables students to satisfy some of the bar requirements during the summer and have more flexibility in their course selections during the academic year.

## HOW TO ENROLL

Please go to the **Registration Form** to enroll. Payment of the first and second admissions tuition deposits is required to process registration. Please note that while the registration deadline is 3:00pm ET on Monday, July 6, we strongly recommend registering by May 15 for visa purposes.

*\*Note: For students who are not able to attend the Summer Experience, but who need to satisfy the New York Bar course requirements during the LL.M., the required courses are also offered during the academic year.*



## TUITION

The tuition for the Summer Experience is \$5,000 and **due by July 6**. This fee covers up to 4 credits: Foundations of American Law, plus either Professional Responsibility or U.S. Legal Research, Writing and Analysis. This fee does not include housing and living expenses. Note that attendance at Foundations is required for students who wish to take either Professional Responsibility in the U. S. or U.S. Legal Research, Analysis and Writing. For payment information go to **Student Accounts** and click on Payment Options.

## HOUSING

On-campus housing is available only during the Foundations of American Law session from July 11–August 1. Students may choose from two options and may move into Gewirz apartments as early as Saturday, July 11 ahead of classes starting Monday, July 13. Please reserve your space by June 13. **Cancellations are due no later than June 22**. Housing options:

- Two-Bedroom Apartment (no living room) will cost \$1,717.00
- Two-Bedroom Apartment (with living room) will cost \$1,821.00

We will do our best to accommodate students' preferences for a particular room type, but cannot guarantee that each student will be assigned to his or her first choice of room configuration. Please use the Registration Form to sign up for on-campus housing.
