Resolution 2020–2021-1: Chief of Staff Appointment

WHEREAS Article V, Section 2(g)(i) states that the Chief of Staff shall “be a member of the Association nominated by the Executive Board and confirmed by a two-thirds majority of the House of Delegates”;

WHEREAS Article V, Section 2(g)(ii) states that the Chief of Staff shall “assist in the advocacy, programming, and operations of the Association”;

WHEREAS Article V, Section 2(g)(iii) states that the Chief of Staff shall “preside over debate in the House of Delegates in the absence of the Attorney General”;

WHEREAS Article V, Section 2(g)(iv) states that the Chief of Staff shall “perform such other duties as the President or the House of Delegates may direct”;

WHEREAS Caitlyn has previously served as a student representative on the Student Life & Wellness Committee, and has worked closely with other members of the House of Delegates and Law Center administration; and

WHEREAS the Executive Board finds Caitlyn Cook to be an extremely qualified and capable candidate for the position of Chief of Staff;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

Caitlyn Cook is confirmed as the Chief of Staff for the 2020–2021 House of Delegates.
