

## **CHECKLIST of Important Things to do PRIOR to Orientation**

### **OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT**

Our accrediting association requires us to have, *prior to registration*, an official final transcript for every incoming student showing a baccalaureate degree and the date it was awarded. Please note that transcripts submitted through LSAC are NOT acceptable substitutes for an official transcript. You must submit your official final transcript directly to the Office of Admissions.
