

First-Year Elective Courses for Continuing Students (2021 – 2022)

Section 7 students (including any 1E who is allowed to transfer to the full-time division as of Fall 2019), and any upper-class student with an outstanding first-year elective requirement, must complete their first-year elective requirement in any semester of their choice before graduation.

Once enrolled, students should confirm their degree audit to make sure the requirement is being correctly designated. To access the online degree audit program, MyDegree, log in to [MyAccess](#), click on the “Student Services” tab, and then click on MyDegree. The “First Year Elective Requirement” is listed in the “JD First Year Curriculum Requirements” section of your audit.

If the course elected is not being correctly designated, students should notify the Registrar’s Office at lawreg@georgetown.edu.

Please note that elective courses may not be taken pass/fail.
