Welcome to Georgetown Law! Dean Cornblatt and the Admissions team have been singing your praises all spring, and I am just delighted that you are joining our community this fall.

I am writing to introduce myself as well as to give you a sense of what to expect this summer as you look forward to the start of school. Think of my office and team - the Office of the Dean of Students (known on campus as “ODOS”) - as a portal to the law school. We are a good place to turn to with questions or concerns, large or small, both this summer and beyond. ODOS is home to the Student Life, Residence Life, Sport and Fitness, Disability Services, and Academic Support offices, and our whole team is eager to meet you all on campus during Orientation this August.

Here’s a snapshot of what’s to come:

### **Orientation Week 2022: August 22-26**

ODOS organizes the Orientation Week activities for the entering J.D. class, which will include everything from tours around DC with faculty to casual meals with upperclass mentors to your first law school class. Please note that the mandatory portion of Orientation for J.D. students in the full-time program runs from **Wednesday, August 24 through Friday, August 26**. Most students plan to arrive a few days early, however, as there will be all sorts of voluntary-participation activities that will help you get settled and meet your classmates, from campus tours to meet & greet gatherings. We will keep you posted on all of this, as well as how to sign up for any optional programming, in the coming 4-6 weeks.

### **Peer Advisors**

Starting in July, you can expect to receive messages from your Peer Advisor, an upperclass student who is here to be a resource, tour guide, and mentor as you acclimate to DC and Georgetown. They will be available during Orientation and throughout the fall semester to support you and your transition into 1L year.

### **Looking Ahead to the 1L Experience**

There is lots of advice out there about how to approach law school and in particular your 1L year, so much so that it can sometimes be difficult to sort through it all and apply it to your own experience here at Georgetown. Our team, along with a variety of campus partners, will be with you along the way to give you a sense of what to expect before and throughout the academic year. We will also help prepare you for the decisions you will make in order to create the best possible law school experience for YOU, based on your own personal and professional goals. We will kick off later this summer, through Orientation and beyond. Stay tuned!
